



# BELUR, HALEBIDU, SHRAVANABELAGOLA

01 night & 02 days



### Itinerary:

**Day 1 – Bangalore-Belur & Halebid (Distance: 220 Kms, approximate travel time: 4 hours by road)**

The temples of Belur and Halebid are best known for their south Indian architecture. The temples at both these places are built by renowned architect Jakkanna Acharya. This temple of Belur and Halebid are being proposed as UNESCO world heritage site.

Check in to the hotel and overnight stay at Hassan.

**Day 2 – Hassan-Shravanabelagola (Distance: 56 Kms, approximate travel time 1 hour, 10 minutes by road)**

This small town boasts of the largest number of Digambara temples as well as the largest number of inscriptions in the country. The cynosure of the centuries, Gommateshwara towers in his 57 feet solitary serene splendour, over the surrounding countryside. This freestanding monolithic statue, which crowns the 438 feet high present-day Indragiri or Vindhyagiri, hewn out of granite is the largest of its kind in the world.

Proceed for Bangalore in the evening.

**Shravanabelagola – Bangalore (Distance: 145 Kms, approximate travel time 3 hours; 10 minutes by road)**
