



CHITRADURGA & HAMPI HOLIDAY

03 nights & 04 days



Itinerary:

Day 1 – Bangalore- Chitradurga (Distance: 203 Kms, approximate travel time :3 hours 30 minutes by road)

Chitradurga(also known locally as Durga) is a city and the headquarters of which is located on the valley of the Vedavati river in the southern part of the Indian state of Karnataka.

Chitradurga features bold rock hills and picturesque valleys, huge towering boulders in numerous shapes. It is known as the "stone fortress".

Visit the famous Chitradurga Fort, proceed to Davangere (Distance: 60kms, approximate travel time : 1hour by road)

Check into hotel and overnight stay at Davangere.

Day 2 – Davangere - Hampi (Distance: 136 Kms, approximate travel time :3 hours 30 minutes by road)

Hampi (Hampe) is a village and temple town recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and has numerous temple complexes from the Vijayanagara Empire. On the south bank of the River Tungabhadra is the 7th-century Hindu Virupaksha Temple, near the revived Hampi Bazaar. A carved stone chariot stands in front of the huge Vittala Temple site.

Overnight stay at Hampi

Day 3- Hampi Sightseeing

Breakfast at the hotel

In Hampi at every turn there is a surprise. Every monument hides more than what they reveal.

Visit Elephant stables, Monkey temple, Steeped tank, Vitala temple complex., Queen bath.

Day 4-Hampi –Tungabhadra Dam (Distance: 26 Kms, approximate travel time :45 minutes by road)

The Tungabhadra Dam is constructed across the Tungabhadra River, a tributary of the Krishna River. It is a multipurpose dam serving irrigation, electricity generation, flood control, etc.

Proceed to Bangalore

Hampi–Bangalore (Distance: 334 Kms, approximate travel time: 6 hours 15 minutes by road)
