



MALE MAHADESHWARA HILLS

01 night & 02 days



Itinerary:

Day 1 – Bangalore – Male Mahadeshwara Hills (Distance: 230 Kms, approximate travel time: 6 hours by road)

Start your journey to Shivanasamudra waterfalls

The Shivanasamudra Falls is on the Kaveri River after the river has wound its way through the rocks and ravines of the Deccan Plateau and drops off to form waterfalls. The island town of Shivanasamudra divides the river into twin waterfalls. This creates the fourth largest island in the rivers course. A group of ancient temples are located here and there likely was a village.

Visit the waterfalls.

Then proceed to the famous Shiva temple at Mahadeshwara hills popularly M M Hills.

The ancient and sacred temple of Sri Male Mahadeshwara is located in South end of India, that is, it belongs to Chama raja Nagar District, Karnataka State in India. It is a very popular & holy ancient temple, surrounded by 77 hills in the Eastern Ghats. The Lord Sri Mahadeshwara is believed to be the incarnation of Lord Shiva. It is a very famous Shaiva pilgrim centre. The Lord Sri Mahadeshwara' s miracles are beautifully sung by the village folk in Janapada Style. The height of the hill is about 3000 feet from the sea level.

Overnight stay.

Day 2 –M M Hills to Bangalore (Distance: 250 Kms, approximate travel time 6 hours)

Visit temple for early morning Aarthi.

After temple darshan proceed your journey to Bangalore.
